Who should attend LHNE?

Is LHNE accredited?

Yes, LHNE has earned Rules 10 Accreditation from the Nebraska Department of Education.

What courses are offered at LHNE?

Courses are offered in English/Language Arts, Social Science/History, Theology, Mathematics, Science, Health & PE, Foreign Language (currently Spanish), Fine Arts (including music and art), and Practical Arts (including business and computers). Does LHNE prepare students for college?

Classroom instruction at LHNE is excellent. Both challenging and nurturing, teachers prepare students on an individual basis for the challenges of college and life. Teachers have high expectations for their students and assist them in their quest for future success and service to their community and world.

Does LHNE offer financial aid and scholarships?

We will work to the best of our ability to help families afford the cost of Lutheran High Northeast. We have up to \$150,000 available in scholarship assistance this current school year.

Does my child have to be Lutheran to attend?

LHNE has students who are affiliated with a variety of Christian church denominations.



I understand that Theology classes are part of the curriculum at LHNE. Will you try to convert my child in these classes?

Though LHNE does teach theology from a Lutheran perspective, LHNE's purpose in teaching theology is not to make other Christians become Lutheran. Rather, theology classes serve as a foundation for faith development and challenge students to mature in faith as they approach the world with a servant heart. LHNE seeks to share the truth of Jesus Christ and salvation through Him alone in a world that claims there are many ways to salvation.

Which sports are offered at LHNE?

LHNE is a member of the Nebraska State Activities Association (NSAA) and offers a variety of sports. Girls' sports include basketball, soccer, track and field, cross country, dance squad, softball (coop with NHS), swimming (coop with NHS), and volleyball. Boys' sports include baseball (coop with NHS), basketball, soccer, track and field, golf, cross country, football, swimming (coop with NHS), and wrestling.

Does LHNE have any extra-curricular activities or clubs?

LHNE offers students the opportunity to become involved in chess club concert band and choir, drama, Eagle student ambassadors, FBLA, mock trial, National Honor Society, NECC academic competition, quiz bowl, show choir, pep band, speech, and student government.

Is transportation to LHNE available for my child? What about carpooling?

LHNE works with families in other communities to arrange transportation through car pools. Students currently travel from five area counties in Northeast Nebraska within a 50-60 mile radius. If transportation is a concern, please notify Principal, Dan Sievert so that we can help find a solution.
